Naloxone (Narcan[®]) is a medication that reverses the effects of an opioid overdose. It is safe and easy to use. Anyone at risk of having or seeing an opioid overdose, or who spends time with people who use opioids, should consider carrying naloxone.

Naloxone is available to anyone who requests it.
Monday – Friday from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.
No appointment necessary.

Just ask lobby staff for naloxone or Narcan[®]. **No ID required.** A staff member will provide a rescue kit after going over the signs & symptoms of an opioid overdose and how to use Narcan[®].
